

About the D2L Student Training

Students who are taking **any** fully online or hybrid courses are required to complete the **D2L Student Training**. They must pass the cumulative quiz, with a score of **80% or better**, before they can access their online or hybrid courses. Students who have not successfully completed the training have a “hold” on their D2L account – the hold is released when the **D2L Student Training Quiz** is completed with an 80% or better score.

NOTE: Students can retake the quiz repeatedly until they attain a score of **80% or better**.

Once your training quiz is completed with a score of 80% or better, your completion certificate appears as an Announcement and the hold is released.



What Is the D2L Student Training?

A short D2L training (about 1 hour) that prepares students to understand:

- What is different about taking courses online versus in the classroom.
- How to use and navigate D2L.
- How to access course content and submit coursework in D2L.
- How to be successful when taking classes online.

Who Should Complete the D2L Student Training?

- All students enrolled in fully online and hybrid courses are required to complete the **D2L Student Training** before being able to access their courses in D2L.
- The **D2L Student Training** is designed for quick completion—usually in less than an hour.

How Does the D2L Student Training Work?

To access the **D2L Student Training** :

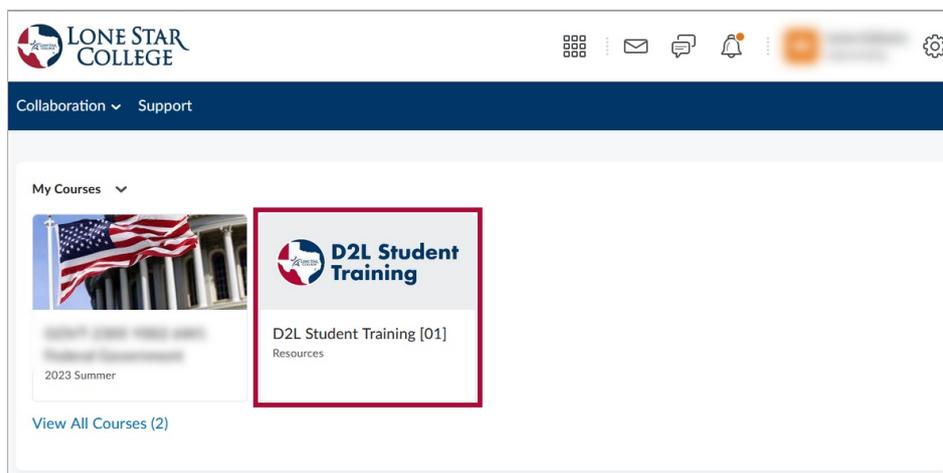
1. Login to [myLoneStar \(https://my.lonestar.edu/\)](https://my.lonestar.edu/) and click on the **[LSC Online]** tile.



2. Click on the **[Brightspace D2L]** tile. The **D2L Homepage** will open in a new tab.



3. You will be on your **D2L Homepage**. On your course list, click on the **[D2L Student Training]** tile.



4. On the course homepage, click **[Content]** and follow the on-screen instructions to begin the D2L Student Training process.

5. Work through the material in the D2L Student Training through the navigation: **[Start Here: D2L Student Training]** -> **[D2L Lesson]**. Click **[D2L Student Training Quiz]** to access the training quiz after you are finished with the lesson.

NOTE: After you successfully score an **80% or higher** on the quiz, you will be able to access your courses **on or after the course start date**. You will **NOT** be able to access your D2L course before the course's start date.
