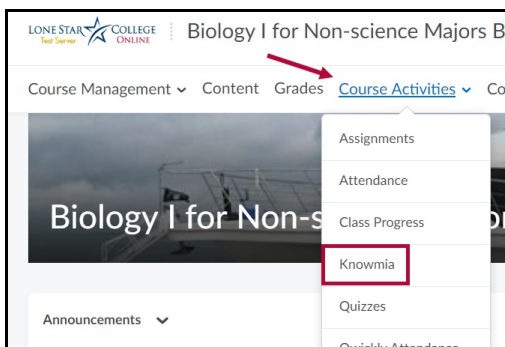
## Record with the TechSmith Knowmia Recorder

The TechSmith Knowmia Recorder provides a simple, straightforward video creation experience that will allow users to easily create screencasts or webcam videos to put into their courses.

Advantages to this recorder include:

- You can view videos immediately after upload.
- You can record specific regions of your screen, as well as full-frame webcam videos. You can even switch between screen and webcam while you are recording.
- You don't need admin rights, and the recorder is a small download and a lightweight installation on any machine.

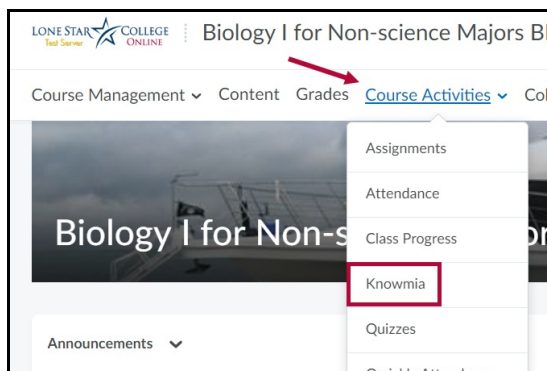

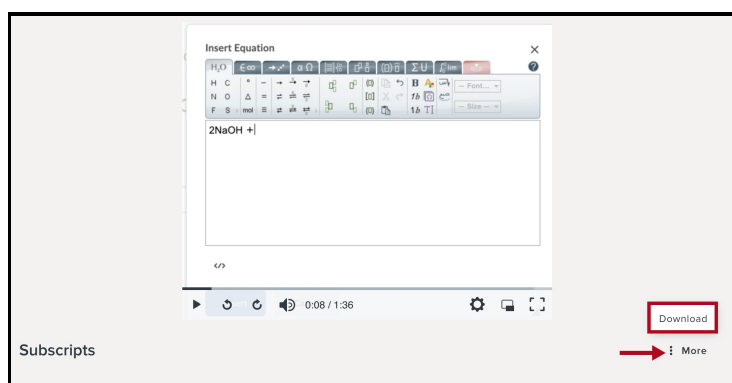

## Download Knowmia Videos

Your professor may have set up the Knowmia videos in your course to allow you to download them. If you download the videos, then you will be able to watch them at a later date even if you do not have an internet connection. If your professor has set this up, you can download the video by following the steps below.

### Download Knowmia Videos

1. Access the Knowmia video in your course content.
2. Beneath the video, click the **More** link then click **Download**.



3. Your video will download to the default location for your browser.
