ProctorU Live+

ProctorU Live+ is a **live proctoring** solution utilized by Lone Star College that allows online and distance learners to take proctored exams without needing to visit a Testing Center.

All quizzes taken in ProctorU, with the exception of **Practice Quizzes**, are taken by students in front of a live **Proctor**, who will monitor your surroundings and entire desktop throughout the exam. There is no cost to students to use **ProctorU Live+**.

NOTE: On November 6, 2025, ProctorU is retiring the legacy ProctorU Chrome and Firefox extensions. After this release, you will see an error message when attempting to connect to your exam using the legacy browser extension. **Follow these instructions to uninstall any legacy ProctorU extensions from Chrome and/or Firefox.**



Getting Started with the ProctorU Platform

Follow this <u>step-by-step process (https://support.proctoru.com/hc/en-us/articles/25557846449037-How-to-Get-Started-with-the-ProctorU-Platform)</u> to prepare yourself for your exam:

1. Sign Up

Create a Test-Taker ProctorU Account (https://go.proctoru.com/registrations).



2. Download the Guardian Browser

Make sure you <u>Download and Install the Guardian Browser</u> (https://support.proctoru.com/hc/articles/24760032813453-How-to-Download-Install-and-Uninstall-the-Guardian-Browser). You can find out where to download **Guardian** and how to install it within the linked article.

3. Scheduling

If you will have a live human-proctored launch, you'll need to Schedule Your Exam (https://support.proctoru.com/hc/en-us/articles/115011622247-How-do-I-schedule-my-exam). If your exam launch will be automated, you do not need to schedule an appointment and may take your exam at any time through D2L.

4. Check Your Equipment

<u>Test Your Equipment (https://go.proctoru.com/users/3425357/system-metrics/new)</u> to make sure your hardware is compatible with **ProctorU**.

5. Find an Acceptable Space to Take Your Exam

The environment needs to be quiet, well-lit, and away from other people. The workspace area needs to be free of all materials other than Materials Allowed During Your Exam (Materials Allowed During Your Exam (https://support.proctoru.com/hc/en-us/articles/115011621827-What-do-l-need-to-have-for-my-exam). Using a hard surface for a workspace is required; beds or couches are not permitted.

6. Become Familiar with Materials Required for Your Exam




Accessing ProctorU

1. Open your course in D2L, navigate to [Course Activities] → [Quizzes].




2. Click on the [ProctorU quiz] that is set by your instructor.

NOTE: The phrase *ProctorU* does not need to be included in the quiz name.



3. Enter the quiz password provided by your instructor or proctor.
