Why Whitelist D2L Emails?

Emails from D2L can sometimes be flagged as junk or spam by your Outlook inbox. To avoid missing critical course-related messages, add D2L email addresses to your **Safe Senders** list.

Add D2L Emails to the Safe Senders List in Outlook Webmail

NOTE: Ensure you are logged into your **LSC Outlook** account before proceeding to avoid access issues.

1. Open [Outlook on the web \(https://outlook.office365.com/\)](https://outlook.office365.com/) and log in using your **MyLonestar** credentials.
2. Click the gear icon [⚙️] in the top-right corner, then select **[View all Outlook settings]**.
3. Expand **[Mail]** on the left panel, select **[Junk email]**.
4. Under **Safe senders and domains**, click **[+ Add]**.
5. Enter then click **[Save]**.

Additionally, if D2L emails are already in your junk folder, right-click the email, select **Mark as not junk**, and optionally choose to always trust emails from the sender.
