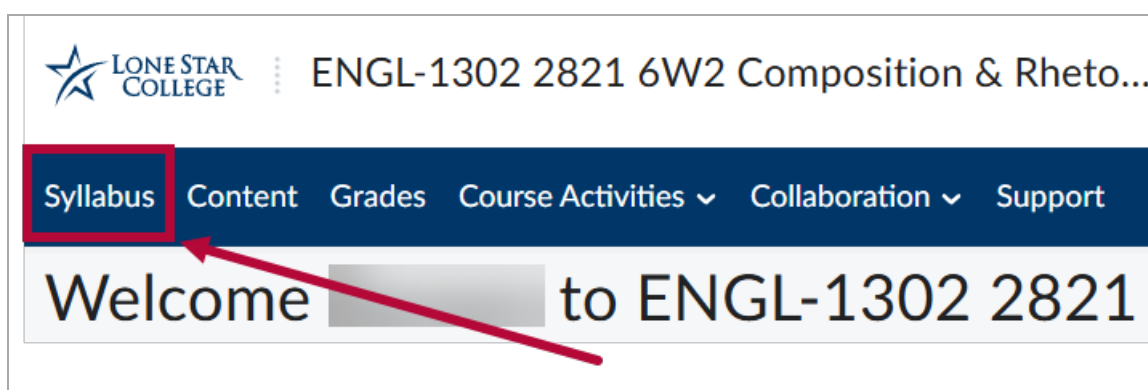

Accessing Your Course Syllabus

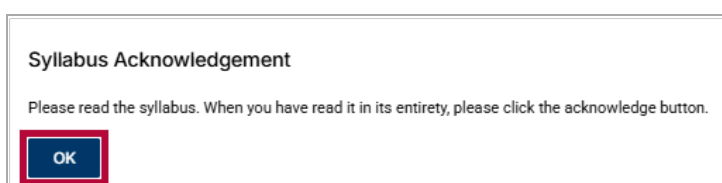
To access your course syllabus, click on the **[Syllabus]** link in the **Navbar**.


Reading & Acknowledging Your Syllabus

- **Check Your Browser Settings:** Make sure cookies are enabled.
